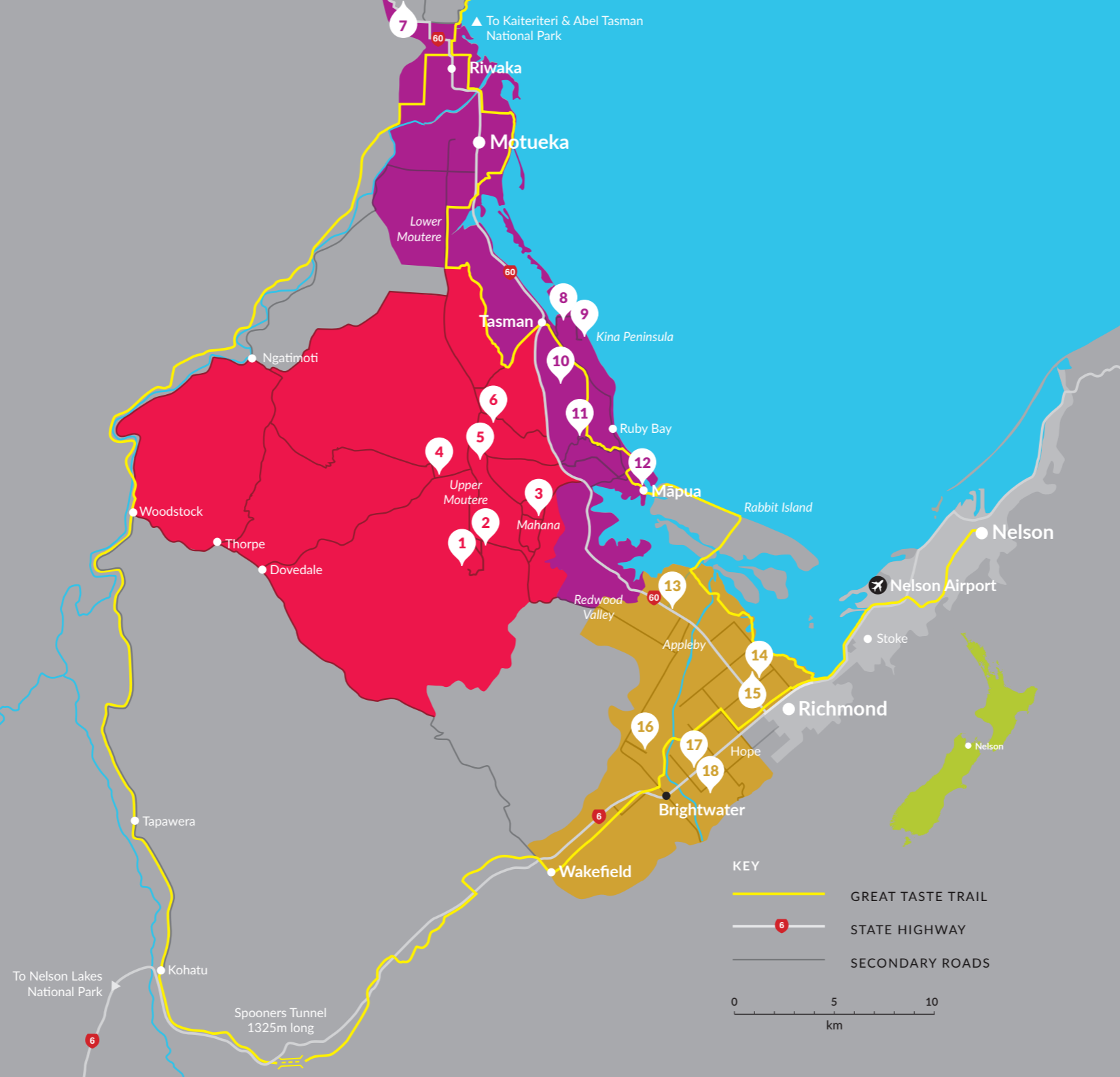
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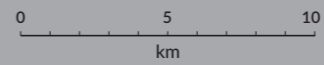

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Moutere Hills

The softly rolling inland Moutere Hills are formed from the weathered gravels of an ancient river system, which originally reached from St Arnaud to Tasman Bay Coast. The gravel threaded clay soils are renowned for producing wines of richness and texture.

The pinot noir is deeply flavoured with refined soft tannins. The chardonnay is complex and multi-faceted with excellent structure. Winemakers also produce excellent sauvignon blanc, riesling and pinot gris.

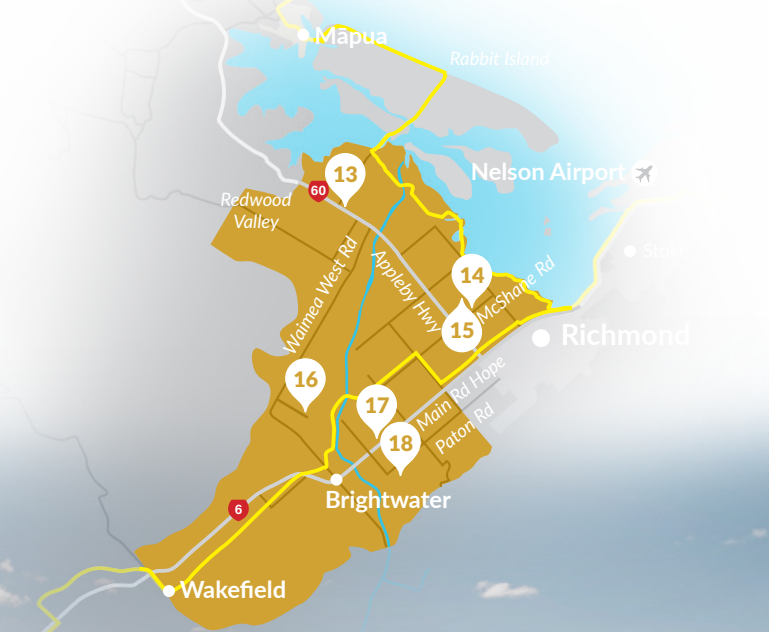


Waimea Plains

Waimea means ‘river gardens’ in Māori – with stony soils of alluvial origin and high sunshine hours, the climatically diverse Waimea Plains provide great terroir.

The aromatic whites are ‘vibrant wines’, with a flinty backbone acting as a counterpoint to the overt fruit flavours.

The chardonnay here is richly expressive with fine acid structure. The pinot noir is perfumed with plum and cherry characters on the nose and the ripeness carries through to supple tannins on the palate.
